

TOWN OF DEEP RIVER
LAND SWAP REFERENDUM
December 22, 2004

A referendum of electors and citizens qualified to vote at Town Meetings in said Town was held at the Deep River Library Community Room, 150 Main Street, Deep River, on Monday, December 20, 2004, between the hours of 12 noon and 8 p.m. for the approval of the following question:

“Shall the Town authorize the Board of Selectmen to negotiate and enter into an agreement on behalf of the Town to exchange its property known as 184-188 Main Street for property known as 180 Main Street to be acquired by Turnpike Properties (or nominee) and improved as a municipal parking lot, such exchange to be on conditions advantageous to the Town and generally set forth in a certain draft Sale, Purchase and Exchange Agreement as prepared by Town Counsel?”

Voting was by machine, and a total of 530 votes were cast. This includes 11 absentee ballots (one was rejected), and 12 votes cast by property owners only. Patricia Gamerdinger served as moderator. Total names on registry list were 3,194. Turnout of voters was 16.5%.

Votes Cast: Yes 347 No 183

Question was approved. Vote was sent to referendum by petition asking that the vote be sent to referendum with vote by machine. The petition contained 312 certified names.
