TOWN OF DEEP RIVER TOWN HALL EXPANSION AND RENOVATION PROJECT October 23, 2007

A budget referendum of electors and citizens qualified to vote at Town Meetings in said Town was held at the Deep River Library, 150 Main Street, Deep River, on Tuesday, October 23, 2007, between the hours of 6 a.m. and 8 p.m. for a vote on the following question:

"SHALL THE TOWN OF DEEP RIVER APPROPRIATE \$2,985,000 FOR THE TOWN HALL EXPANSION AND RENOVATION PROJECT TO BE FUNDED IN PART FROM \$400,000 TOWN HALL CAPITAL FUND AND \$100,000 GENERAL FUND BALANCES, AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF \$2,485,000 BONDS AND NOTES TO FINANCE THE REMAINDER OF THE APPROPRIATION TO THE EXTENT NOT FINANCED FROM GRANTS?"

A vote of YES being approval, and a vote of NO being a vote for disapproval.

Voting was by machine. A total of 954 votes were cast—937 by machine and 17 by absentee ballot. Patricia Gamerdinger served as moderator. Of the voters twenty-one were nonresident property owners; 933 were registered voters.
